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Cannot Aid Jews if Saar Goes to Reich

A Lunatic Asylum
THE appointment of Julius Streicher, editor of the rabid anti-Jewish weekly *Der Sturmer*, as government commissioner for Franconia, lends official sanction to the most disgusting and dastardly activities of this perverted anti-Semite. The articles and cartoons appearing in his *Sturmer*, often sadistic and pornographic in character, have incited the German populace in the Nuremberg region to anti-Jewish riots and have led to bloodshed. The maddest of all the mad Jew-haters, Julius Streicher, now becomes a representative of his district in the so-called Bavarian Cabinet Council. Streicher's notorious record as an enemy of the Jewish people is based on his long unscrupulous agitation by means of the forged "Protocols" and other exploded myths and legends. He has constantly incited acts of violence against the Jews.

League Jurists Powerless to Impose Obligation, Report

GENEVA, April 13.—Should the Saar plebiscite be held in 1935, favor return to Germany, the League of Nations Council would have no right to impose special obligations for the protection of racial minorities, jurists of the League are said to have declared.

Under the provisions of the treaty the inhabitants of the Saar valley will have to vote on a return to Germany, inclusion in the French Republic or a continuation of the present League Commission government.

It is understood that the conclusion of the League jurists is based on a jurist's memorandum which the League committee in charge of organizing the Saar plebiscite will consider when it meets in Rome on Monday.

The opinion of the jurists is based on the fact that the Versailles Treaty clauses dealing with the Saar region do not contain specific regulations for the protection of minorities to enable the League to dictate on the treatment of minorities there.

However, even the formal conclusions of the jurists cannot prevent the Council of the League from specially recommending special clauses for the protection of minorities in the Saar region.

Mills Will Head Immigration Dept' Of Palestine May 1

JERUSALEM, April 13.—Eric Mills, Assistant Chief Secretary of the Palestine government and Acting Chief Secretary during the Palestine riots of 1929, has been appointed Director of the Immigration Department, the Jewish Telegraphic Agency learned today.

The appointment of Mills will be confirmed officially this week and he will assume the post on May 1, it was stated.

Mills succeeds Albert Montefiore Hyman, Jewish director of the immigration department since 1924.

Darré Hits Former Parties As Their Tools; Liberalism Jewish Egoism, He Asserts

Reich Papers Again Carry Anti-Semitic Propaganda—Berlin Forbids Jews to Act in German Language Films

BERLIN, April 13.—For the first time in months a direct attack against Jews by a Nazi cabinet minister appeared today. Richard Walther Darré, Nazi Minister of Agriculture, in an article in the *Deutsche Zeitung*, declared that all former German political parties founded by Jews, who made "their political manoeuvres dance for selfish Jewish ends."

Darré said that the "Jew, Stalin, founded the Conservative group; Marx and La Salle, Marxism, while Liberalism is nothing but the Jewish entrenchment of egoism."

"The antithesis of all this egoism based only on Jewish conceptions is Nazism," Darré declared, pointing out that Nazism is proclaiming the principle of blood and soil in the agrarian aphorism, where the Jew profits from every crisis."

"Jew is mortal enemy."

All over Germany the provincial papers are once more carrying articles calling for the boycotting of Jewish shops and declaring that the recent declarations permitting Nazi party members to buy from Jews is false and that Nazis are still forbidden to buy from them.

"The Jew is the mortal enemy of the German people and there is no more effective attack on him than by hitting his purse," the Nazi press said.

At Ickefeldt, near the Belgian border, tickets for the municipal theatre were issued to indigent people of the town, but all applicants for the tickets were required to prove their "Aryan" origin.

A sign has been posted at the neo-pagan sunbath in the Mannheim stadium reading, "Non-Aryans strictly forbidden."

In Brunswick insulting inscriptions were painted with corrosive acid on Jewish shop windows, despite the announcement by local police that such acts were damaging to German national economy.
